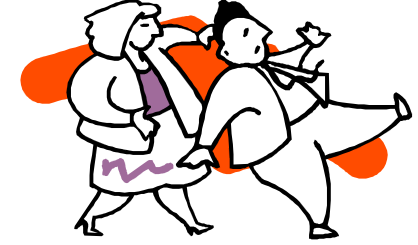

## Program Overview

Falls in the long term care setting remain a complex, challenging problem for providers. For the resident, falls often result in fear of further falls, serious injury, hospitalization or even death. Only through individualized, person-centered risk identification and development of a comprehensive, interdisciplinary fall management process can providers begin to effectively reduce falls and fall-related injuries. This program is intended to assist staff across various disciplines in developing person-centered strategies to manage fall risks, and outline the essential elements necessary to implement a comprehensive fall management process.

## Learning Objectives

Participants will learn how to:

- Identify person-centered approaches to fall management that may promote positive resident outcomes
- Examine intrinsic and extrinsic risk factors that comprise a person-centered assessment
- Analyze fall risk assessment tools and a post-fall investigation process
- Discuss the process of utilizing the full interdisciplinary team in developing a person-centered care plan
